In Maths Olympiad, Senior secondary level (class 11 & 12), Souparna pal bagged the first position. In the Senior level (Class 9 & 10), Sushant Rana scored the second position. In the Junior level (Class 7 & 8), the second position was bagged by Palak.

In the Science Activity category, at the Senior Secondary level (class 11 & 12), the First position was bagged by Akshansh Sharma. At the Senior level (Class 9 & 10), Nitigyasoni attained the first position. At the Junior level (Class 7 & 8), the First position was bagged by Ritesh Nandi.

In the Science quiz category, at the Junior level (class 7 & 8), the First position was attained by Samridhi and Disha Thakur.

In Science Innovative model category, at the Senior level (Class 9 & 10) Third position was bagged by Aditya Vishwanath.

Science Congress (District Level):

30th Himachal Pradesh Children Science Congress (District level) was held in Government Model Senior Secondary School, Chautra, Joginder Nagar, from the 21st to the 23rd of November. Around 600 Students from 12 sub-divisions of Mandi district participated in different competitions. Competitions were conducted in 6 different categories: Maths Olympiad, Science activity, Science quiz, Innovative model making, Survey Research Project and Science Skit. In all these categories, 24 students from Mind Tree IIT Mandi Campus School gave a brilliant performance. 17 of them bagged prizes in different categories.



Souparna Pal competed with his senior opponents in Maths Olympiad, Senior Secondary category and bagged the 1st prize. Nitigya Soni stood first in the senior category of the science activity corner, whereas Ritesh Nandi won first position in the junior category. Both had 6 rounds of activities based on Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, IT and Origami and topped in written tests, viva and the practical experiment rounds.

Abhishree, Shatakshi, Harshika and Anjika of class 9 received the first prize in Scientific Survey Report (under -14) category. The team did the survey research on the Hygiene and well-being of Cattle in the Kamand, Mandi, and Kataula areas. This team got appreciation from each of the judges and became the first ever proud recipients of the BSKD Memorial Award.

Aditya Viswanath obtained 2nd prize in the Innovative Model Making Competition. He designed solar powered water treatment system by electro coagulation. Disha, Samridhi of Class 8, qualified for the screening rounds and got 3rd position in the junior category science quiz.

A Science skit competition was introduced this year at Science Congress. The team of Vidit, Vanshika, Vibhuti, Sidharth, Akshara, Avni and Vaishnavi won 3rd prize in this category.

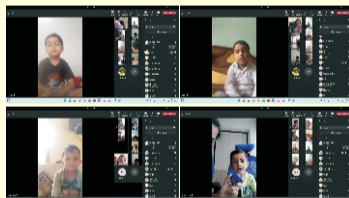
The winners will now represent Mandi District at State-level Science Congress, which will be held at IIT MANDI in December.

September 20, 2022: Questa Quiz Competition - Nursery:

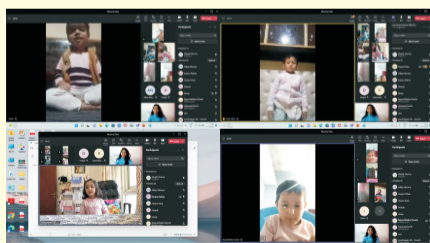

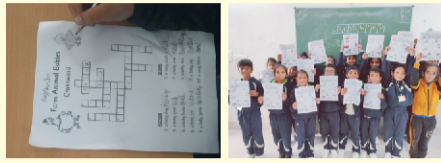
November 17, 2022: Technothon Competition - Grade VII & VIII:
