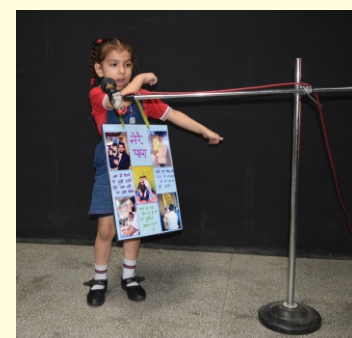
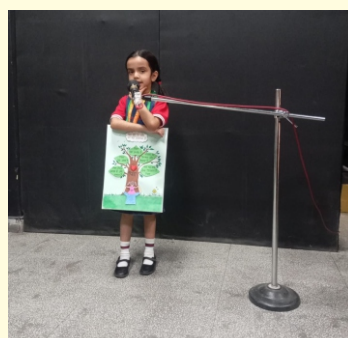
May 6, 2026: Hindi Rhyme Recitation Competition - UKG:
