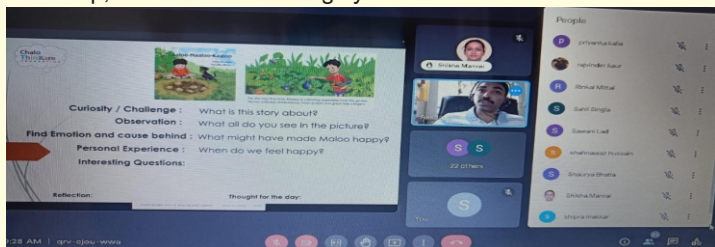
It was an interactive session wherein the parents opened up on the various issues they faced. Here's a glimpse:
