April 02, 2026: Assembly on 'Embracing Differences : World Autism Awareness Day' - Grades VII-X:



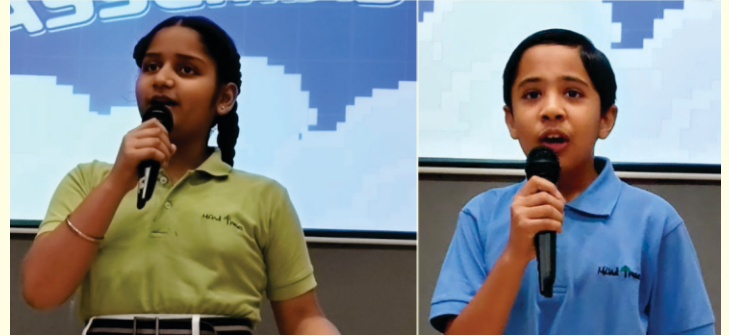

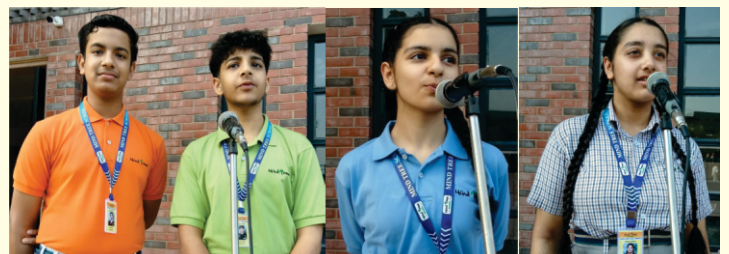

April 29, 2026: Assembly on Truth–'The Light That Never Fades' –Grade VI:



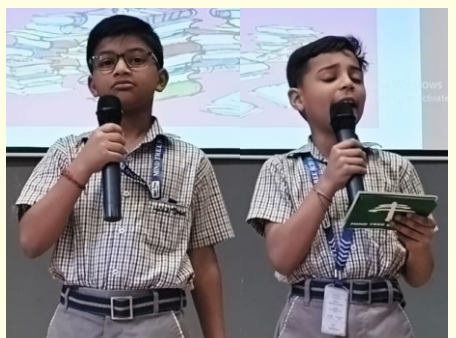

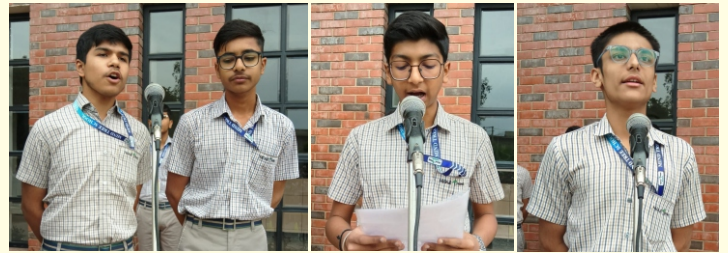

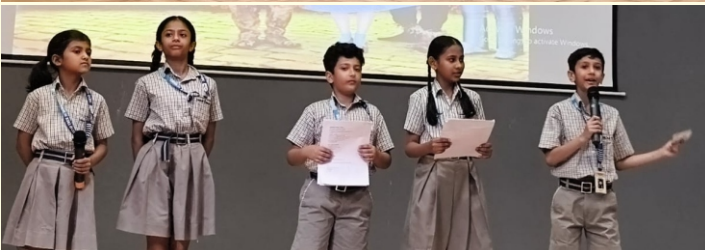


May 06, 2026: Assembly on 'Towards a Greener Tomorrow' – Grades VII-X:

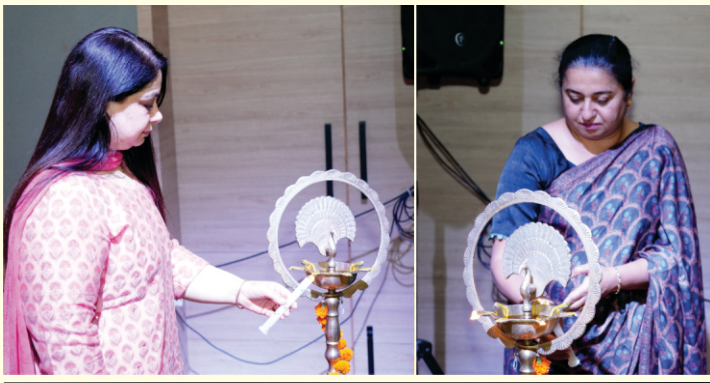
May 12, 2026: Assembly on 'Every Moment Counts' – Grade V:

May 02, 2026: Language Workshop for Young Learners – Grades VI–VIII:



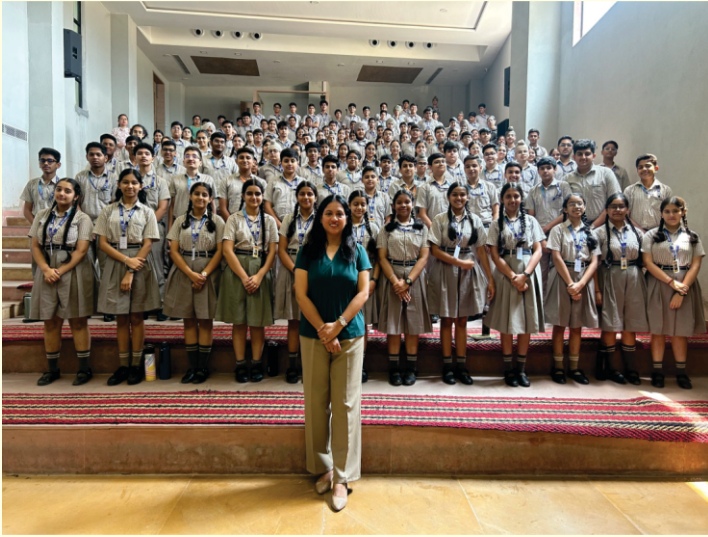

May 04-05, 2026: The Language of Expression – Grades VI - X:



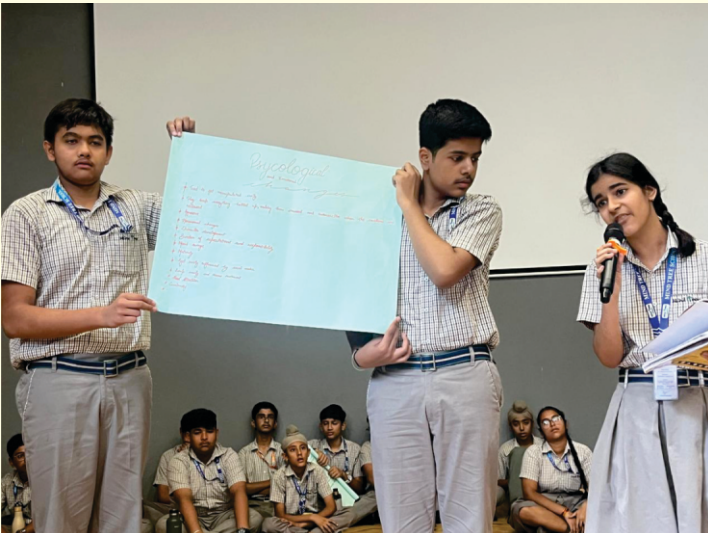
