In order to educate children about signals this activity was taken under the current theme 'Transport'. Traffic lights preserve decorum and control the flow of traffic .

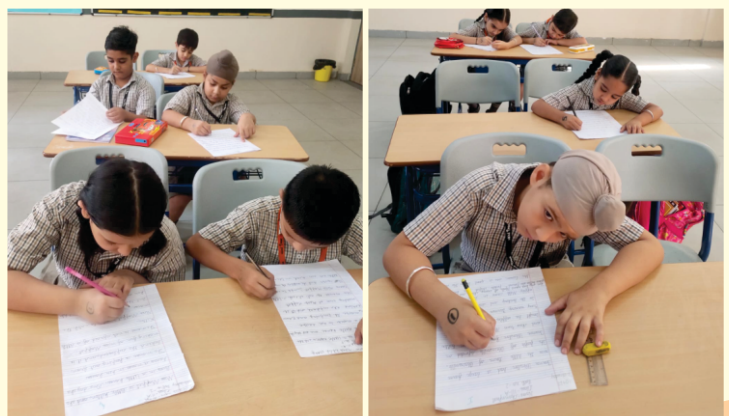
This activity was conducted to make LKG students understand the meaning of traffic signals on 24th May, 2022.
