Sub: Microsoft Teams Login Credentials and Setup for Online Learning Readiness

Dear Parents

As part of our preparedness for any unforeseen circumstances that may require the transition to online learning during the academic session, the Microsoft Teams login credentials for your ward have already been communicated to you. We request all parents to complete the Microsoft Teams setup on their devices at the earliest to ensure that students are ready to attend online classes whenever required.

For parents who are new to Microsoft Teams, please note the following:

1. Download and install the following two applications on your device:
 - ❖ **Microsoft Authenticator**
 - ❖ **Microsoft Teams**
2. Enter the provided User ID and Password in **Microsoft Authenticator** first.
3. Once the authentication process is completed, use the same User ID and Password to log in to Microsoft Teams.
4. The login credentials (User ID and Password) have already been shared with you.

For any clarification or assistance regarding the setup process, please contact the school at 9216032222 or visit the school office between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. on 29 May or 30 May 2026.

Please note: At present, only Grades IX and X will be attending online classes during the summer vacation period from 01 June to 13 June 2026. Should online classes be planned for any other grade, parents will be informed well in advance.

I hope and pray that you and your families are safe and healthy. It's once again time to break for the much awaited summer vacation.

While summer vacation is all about lazing and chilling, watching movies and playing games, it's also a perfect opportunity to engage children meaningfully in productive activities. To ensure this, students of Grades Nursery-VII have been given Holiday Fun Booklets which I'm sure the children will thoroughly enjoy working on. For Grades VIII-X, teachers will be assigning HW/posting HW worksheets which students must complete independently.
