Students also learnt about the **OFC (optical fiber cable)** which can carry millions of signals at one time. Information about the **Base module** was given, wherein they saw different cards and understood about their usage. They also saw the **power supply unit** which was backed up by a generator and standby batteries. This unit is able to supply power to the entire exchange in case of a power failure and also convert AC supply to DC supply to be used in the exchange equipment.
