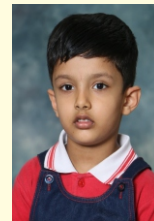

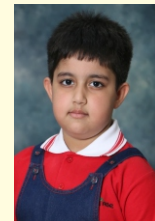


May 13, 2022: Special Assembly on Budh Purnima :

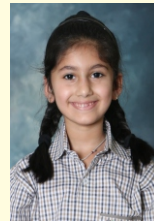

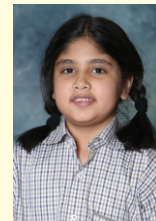
