Self-Defence Camp:

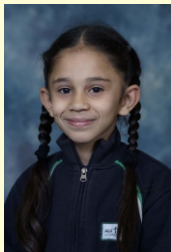

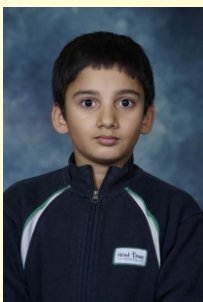
