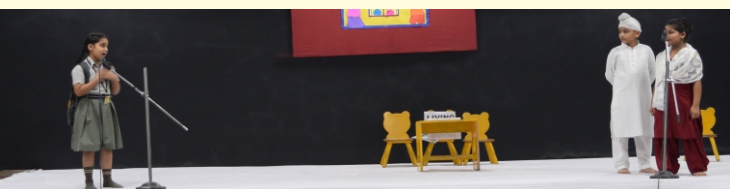




September 09, 2022: Special Assembly on Grandparent's Day:
