

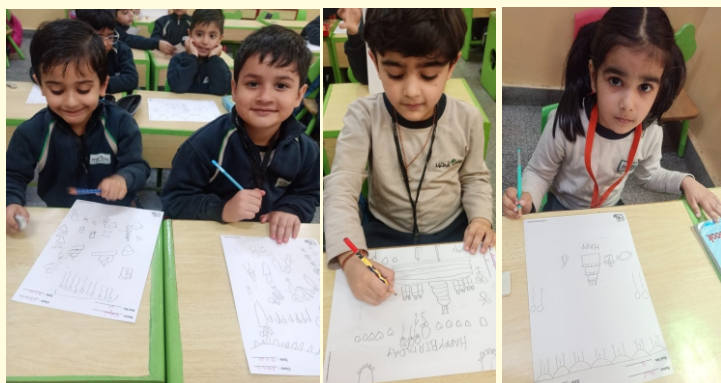
March 10, 2023: Creative Drawing Competition - LKG:
