### Atal Tinkering Laboratory (ATL):



ATL (Atal Tinkering Laboratory) is a workspace where young minds can give shape to their ideas through hands on experience; and learn innovation skills. Young children get a chance to work with tools and equipment to understand the concepts of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math).

In order to provide a technical and managerial bent to mind and encourage the students to think in a resourceful way, ATL conducts different activities ranging from regional and national level competitions, exhibitions, workshops on problem solving, designing and fabrication of products to lecture series at periodic intervals.

Our mentor Mr. Sujay K Nayak, organized many workshops in which students need to find the problems which are being faced by the humanity and then explore solutions to those problems. After attending several different sessions, over a period of time, students have refined their skills such as design mindset, computational thinking, adaptive learning, physical computing and furthermore, entrepreneurial skills.

The topic chosen by a team consisting of three members Shreyans Arora, Navya Ahuja and Samridhi Oberoi for their project is based on farming. The team is planning to create a device that will check the pH of the soil and the ratio of the nutrients present in it. Based on those readings, it will suggest the crops that will be the best to grow on that type of soil. The device will help the farmers to get the best yield from the crops. The mentor helped the students to create the body of the device. Coding that they learned during workshops proved to be of great help.

Mind Tree School has given a platform to its young innovators by joining hands with ATL. The executor of the lab Ms. Anuradha Saini and the mentor guide the students and provide them help with all the means necessary.
