The exhibits in this museum covers 5000 years of Indian history, from the Indus Valley Civilization to the present day. A key highlight of the museum is , the first of its kind in Asia, a two-storeyed cyclorama depicting the evolution of life on the Earth. It has geological landscape paintings, illustrating the origin of life through various time periods. They also came across Early Stone Age tools of India and fossils of Mammoth. After museum, the children explored Rock Garden where Nek Chand –its founder had salvaged a variety of debris from demolished structures, discarded street lights, electrical fittings, broken sanitary ware, crockery, etc. thus demonstrating how waste can be fruitfully recycled and used in creative pursuit.
