April 30, 2014: Calligraphy Competition - Grade I - II:

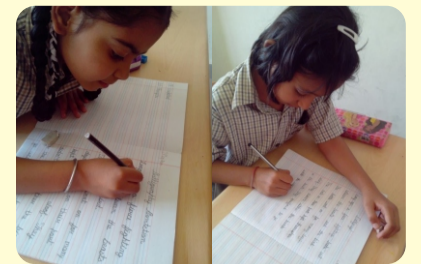
