# 'Education is a shared commitment between dedicated teachers, motivated students and enthusiastic parents.'





May 12, 2023: Splish Splash Poolside Activity - UKG:


## "If there is magic on this planet, it is contained in water."


#### April 21, 2023: Voice Out (Speech Competition) - Grade IX & X:


