EDUCATOR'S CORNER

Workshop on Fundamentals of Linguistics:





The science of linguistics has intrigued man since times immemorial and more so in the case of English language, which is often referred to as a mad, mad language.

The school Principal, Ms. Harveen Kaur orchestrated a workshop that focused on the fundamentals of linguistics, phonetics, phonemic awareness, the International Phonetic Alphabet and phonetic transcription. The workshop dealt with the complex phonic code of English, relationship between sound and spelling, letter sound mapping, levels of linguistic analysis, etc. It also focused on learning and practising proper articulation of different vowels, consonants and diphthongs. Engaging with phonics forms the building blocks of learning a language. Decoding letters into their respective sounds is a skill that helps to build reading and writing abilities. The school academic community gained insight into the world of IPA and a notational standard for the phonetic representation of different sounds.
