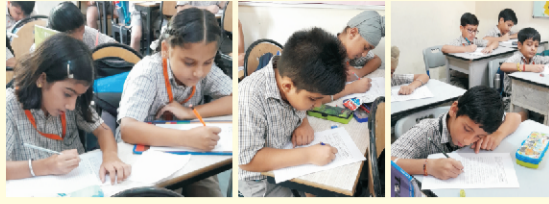

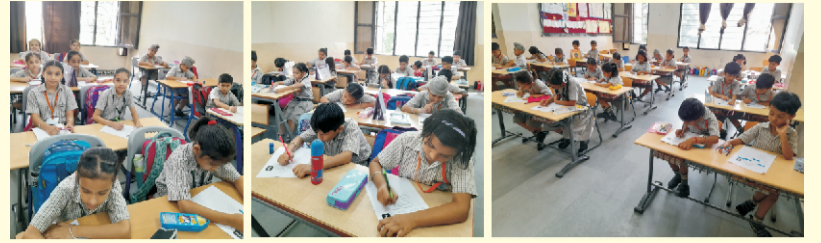

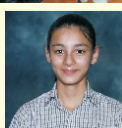
Nawashahr Open Badminton Tournament:
