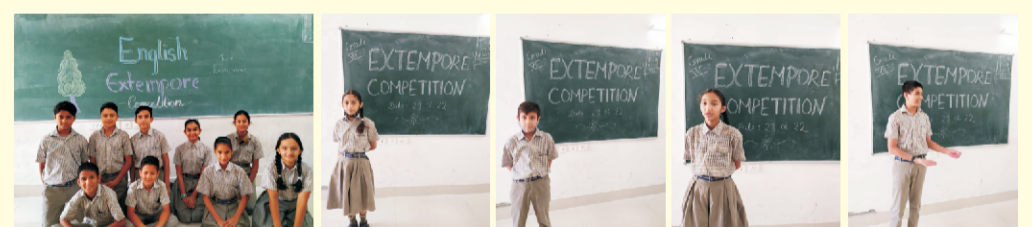
**June 22, 2022: Sudoku Competition - Grade V & VI:**

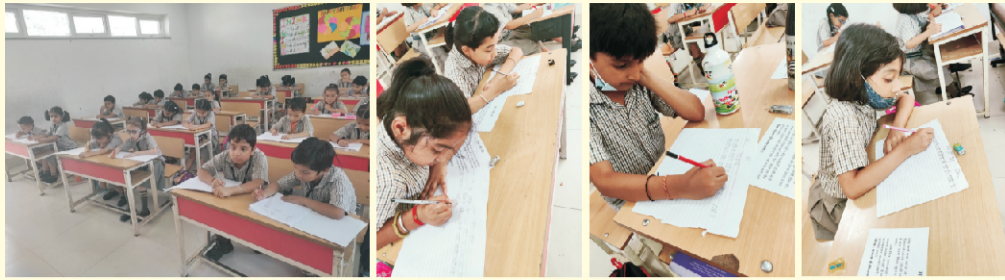

**September 12, 2022: Hindi Recitation Competition - Grade I & II:**

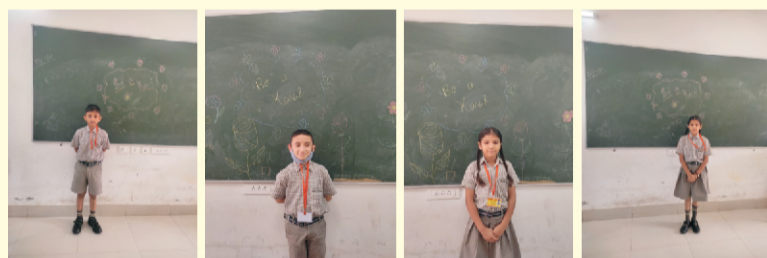
